Minutes of June 2, 2016

The meeting was called to order by Natalie Wolf and the minutes of May 9th were approved with one correction. The date of the second deer culling was changed from March 18th, 2013 to the correct date of March 18th, 2016.

Items on the agenda were the Duke Central Corridor Pipeline Expansion Project and lead water analysis.

The ESC strongly opposed the pipeline and will be issuing a letter to the Ohio Siting Board from the ESC in opposition. Mayor Muething presented a draft Resolution from Council in Opposition to the Pipeline and noted suggestions for improvement of the draft Resolution. Suggestions were made for making the Resolution stronger and clearer. Elida Kamine moved to pass a Resolution that will have all of the recommended modifications. Seconded by Ray Warren and passed unanimously. The HEW will meet next week to approve a final draft.

Councilperson Ray Warren presented information he received from CWW regarding his request of lead water analysis. The results were < 1 ug/L (lead) and 10.7 ug/L (copper). The action level for lead is 15 ug/L and for copper 1,300 ug/L.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
