

POLICE & FIRE COMMITTEE MINUTES

June 4, 2012

Attendees: JK Byar, Rich Bardach, William Doering, Ed Hattenbach, Scot Lahrmer, Rich Wallace, Len Puthoff, and Tom Muething

The meeting was called to order for the purpose of discussing a possible dispatching services agreement between Silverton and Amberley. Under this proposed agreement, Amberley would provide dispatching services to Silverton for a 3 year period and Amberley would receive compensation of \$85,000 for the first year and 87,550 per year for the following 2 years.

Scot Lahrmer explained the background to this proposed agreement. The proposed agreement is the result of ongoing discussions between the communities of Silverton, Deer Park and Amberley to explore ways for the communities to more cost effectively provide services to their respective residents.

Chief Wallace then explained how the services would be provided to Silverton from our existing Dispatch operation. There will be incremental costs to provide the services but the Chief is very confident that Amberley will net at least \$40,000 on an annual basis. This is a win/win for the two communities because Silverton will be able to lower their costs and maintain service and Amberley will also lower its' net costs.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
