

## **STORM WATER ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES**

**September 2, 2015**

Village Manager introduced the new Village Engineer Frank Twehues from CT Consultants. Frank had been with CDS in the past and has returned to the new firm CT Consultants. The committee warmly welcomed Frank to the group

The Committee was advised that the Bids received for the 2015 storm water projects has been rejected by the Streets Committee as recommended by the Village Engineer and Village staff. The Streets Committee had just met prior to this meeting. Bids were rejected due to cost and experience in storm water projects by one of the bidders. Bids came in high probably because most contractors are behind schedule due to the wet weather conditions during this year's construction season. Requests for new bids will be redone after the first of the year. There was concern by the committee why Storm Water had not seen the bids first and the Village manager explained it was a timing issue with meeting schedules and explained Storm water only recommends programs and Streets then recommends to council for formal approval. Since this was a rejection it was not necessary to have Storm water to also reject the bids.

Wayne Signer advised the committee that he would like the committee to consider a possible replacement for him due to his busy schedule.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
