

MAINTENANCE WORKER/FIRE FIGHTER POSITION

Join the ranks of the Maintenance/Fire Department as a skilled and qualified Maintenance Worker/Fire Fighter, a service that is highly valued by the residents you will serve. Bring your existing fire certification or be trained as a Fire Fighter II (240 hour certification) through our department.

As a Maintenance Worker/Fire Fighter you will respond to fire calls while both on duty and off-duty providing the residents with the reassuring knowledge that fully-trained professional help is only minutes away. Many times you will receive the fire call and arrive first on the scene because your maintenance duties had you working just around the corner.

Being a cross-trained Maintenance Worker/Fire Fighter is dual role that contributes at a very high level professionally while increasing your knowledge and skills along with providing a high level of self-satisfaction.

The Community

Amberley Village is primarily a residential community of 3,500 residents located on 3 ½ square miles in Hamilton County. It is a prosperous "first suburb" community bordered by Cincinnati, Reading, Silverton, Golf Manor and Sycamore Township. Amberley Village has a rural feel in an urban area and is located in the center of metropolitan Cincinnati's I-275 loop with the Ronald Reagan Cross County Highway crossing the northern edge of the Village.

Amberley is a full service community with 31 full time employees and a \$3.9 Million General Fund budget. The Village operates under the Council/Manager form of government consisting of a seven member Village Council elected to two-year terms and a Village Manager. The Village's high quality service delivery is carried out through three departments: Police/Fire, Maintenance/Fire and Administration.

The Department

The Maintenance Department is responsible for the maintenance of all Village properties and public right of ways. The Maintenance Department's duties include the maintenance, repair and cleaning of streets, curbs and gutters, ditches, storm sewers, inlets and catch basins, weed and grass cutting, trimming and removal of hazardous trees and brush, bulk leaf collection, traffic signs and pavement markings, snow and ice control, ball field maintenance, public buildings and grounds maintenance, jogging track and playground maintenance/inspection, inspection of public improvements, vehicle and equipment maintenance and repairs, fire apparatus maintenance and smaller scale road repair programs.

The Maintenance Department consists of 7 full time employees: 1 Maintenance Supervisor, 1 Foreman and 5 Maintenance Workers. All seven of the Maintenance Department employees also serve the Village as fully functional firefighters. Once certified as a firefighter, each Maintenance Worker responds to fire calls as needed and attends various training sessions throughout the year.

Assignments vary widely, from a task that may be completed in minutes by a single employee to projects that would involve the entire crew for weeks or months. Variety in job assignments will provide a challenging and rewarding work experience.

In the Maintenance Department there exist individuals with special talents and experience which make them better suited for certain tasks. These specialists operating in their field of expertise help us produce superior results and assist in training their co-workers.

Each employee must be able to obtain and maintain a Class A CDL, perform physical labor in all types of weather, and in many types of situations from the confined spaces of storm sewer pipes, ditches, and holes to working in traffic and along the roadways. All maintenance employees are on 24 hour emergency call-up.

Fire fighting duties include, but are not limited to: on-going training opportunities, responding to fire alarms, emergency to property calls, auto accidents, extrications, structure fires, fire suppression, fire inspections, first aid and first responder training, hazardous materials training, fire apparatus operation and maintenance and equipment and facilities maintenance.
