ORDINANCE 2008-03

ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL
YEAR 2008, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it being necessary to transfer certain Village funds so that sufficient monies will be available for obligations to be met in certain funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, five (5) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the sum of \$40,000.00 be appropriated from the #100 General Fund and transferred to the #400 Capital Projects Fund.

SECTION 2: That the sum of \$20,000.00 be appropriated from the #100 General Fund and transferred to the #410 Capital Projects-Public Facilities Fund.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is for the orderly handling of municipal business.
