ORDINANCE NO. 2008-07

ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION A OF ORDINANCE NO C-729, AS  
SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED, PROVIDING COMPENSATION FOR FIRE  
FIGHTING DUTIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE  
OF OHIO six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

That Subsection A of Ordinance No. C-729, as subsequently amended, be, and the  
same hereby is, amended as follows:

SECTION 1: In Subsection A, the yearly compensation for employees who  
undertake fire fighting duties is hereby increased to \$3,078.50 for firefighting duties, to  
be paid in semiannual installments of \$1,539.25 each in June and December, effective as  
of April 1, 2008.

In Subsection H, the additional yearly compensation for the  
position of Drill master is hereby increased to \$1,614.60, to be paid in semiannual  
installments of \$807.30 each in June and December; the remainder of Subsection H to  
remain as originally ordained.

In Subsection I, the additional yearly compensation for the position  
of Assistant Drill Master is hereby increased to \$1,076.40, to be paid in semiannual  
installments of \$538.20 each in June and December, the remainder of Subsection I to  
remain as originally ordained.

SECTION 2: Except as amended herein and previously, Ordinance C-729 shall  
remain as originally ordained.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it  
shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity of  
maintaining an adequate number of personnel to carry out the work of the Village.
