## ORDINANCE NO. 2008-10

## ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE PUBLIC WORKS SUPERVISOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> The rate of compensation to be paid to the Public Works Supervisor for the Village, effective as of April 1, 2008, shall be not less than \$2,600.00 nor more than \$2,999.99 biweekly; such salary, however, to be subject to a deduction for an Ohio PERS Salary Reduction Method Pick-Up Plan.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity of maintaining an adequate number of personnel to carry out the work of the Village.
