ORDINANCE NO. 2008-14

ORDINANCE ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF ROLLMAN RESERVE SUBDIVISION
PHASES I AND II AND THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS CONTAINED THEREIN,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there having been dedicated to the Village the Rollman Reserve Subdivision Phases I and II, along with the public improvements contained therein; said dedication being demonstrated in the records of the Recorder of Hamilton County, Ohio in Plat Book 526, Page 110, parcels 202, 233, and 234, being Ambercreek Drive, French Park Place, Legacy Trace, and part of Ridge Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the dedication to the Village of the Rollman Reserve Subdivision, together with all public improvements contained therein, be, and hereby are, accepted by the Village.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity for the Village to be able to promptly respond to any need for maintenance of improvements within the Subdivision.
