## ORDINANCE 2008-23

## ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE VILLAGE POLICE/FIRE CHIEF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: Effective as of June 12, 2008, the rate of compensation to be paid to the Village Fire/Police Chief shall be \$4,146.41 biweekly; such salary, however, to be subject to a deduction for a Police & Fire Pension Fund Salary Reduction Method Pick-Up Plan.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity of maintaining adequate personnel to carry out the functions of the Village.
