RESOLUTION 2008-02

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO AWARD MT.
PLEASANT BLACKTOPPING THE 2008 ROAD RESURFACING AND REPAIR
PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Village Manager having been authorized and directed to advertise for bids for road repair and resurfacing, and curb replacement, and bids having been received and considered, and

WHEREAS, the Streets, Public Utilities and Sewers Committee and Village Engineer reviewed the bid and prepared a recommendation that Council has reviewed,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring,

SECTION 1: That the bid of Mt. Pleasant Blacktopping, received in response to the public advertisements requesting proposals for furnishing labor and materials for road repair and resurfacing for a total bid of \$550,908.50 for roadway improvements as listed in Program I and II (attached), being in accordance with the Village's specifications, and being the best total bid; said bid is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: That the Village Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village for the performance of said work by Mt. Pleasant Blacktopping.

SECTION 3: The cost for the street improvements will be taken from the Street Improvement fund.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
