ORDINANCE 2009-04

ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2009,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Village's Public Buildings and Parks Committee having recommended to Council that the property known as Amberley Green be developed and maintained as a Village Park, and

WHEREAS, Council having approved and accepted said Committee's recommendation, and,

WHEREAS, it being Village Council's intention to open the Amberley Green property to Amberley residents for use as a park,

WHEREAS, it being necessary to amend appropriations so that sufficient monies will be available for preparing and operating the property as a park,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the #100 General Fund 2009 Appropriations be increased by \$92,330.00 for the cost of preparing the land for, and operating the property as, a park.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is for the orderly handling of municipality business.
