## ORDINANCE NO. 2009-09

## ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR, MAINTENANCE FOREMAN, AND CREW LEADER, <u>AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY</u>

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The rate of compensation to be paid to the Maintenance Supervisor for the Village, effective as of April 1, 2009, shall be not less than \$2,424.00 nor more than \$2,828.00 biweekly; such salary, however, to be subject to a deduction for an Ohio PERS Salary Reduction Method Pick-Up Plan.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The rate of compensation to be paid to a Maintenance Foreman for the Village shall be not less than \$28.68 per hour nor more than \$29.73 per hour, such salary, however, to be subject to a deduction for an Ohio PERS Salary Reduction Method Pick-Up Plan.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: The rate of compensation to be paid to a Crew Leader for the Village shall be not less than \$28.13 per hour nor more than \$28.68 per hour, such salary, however, to be subject to a deduction for an Ohio PERS Salary Reduction Method Pick-Up Plan.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason of such emergency is the necessity of maintaining an adequate number of personnel to carry out the work of the Village.
