## ORDINANCE 2009-17

## ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE VILLAGE MANAGER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: Effective as of August 1, 2009, the rate of compensation to be paid to the Village Manager shall be \$4,751.42 biweekly; such salary, however, to be subject to a deduction for an Ohio PERS Salary Reduction Method Pick-Up Plan.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity of maintaining adequate personnel to carry out the functions of the Village.
