RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO MAKE ADVANCE  
PAYMENT OF TAXES

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code allows a taxing authority to request payment from the County Auditor of funds derived from taxes or other sources to the County Treasurer, which may be held on account of a local subdivision,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO seven (7) members elected thereto concurring,

SECTION 1: That the Auditor and the Treasurer of Hamilton County in accordance with Ohio Revised Code §321.34, be requested to draw and pay to Amberley Village upon the written request of Margie Crowley, Finance Administrator, and Rick Kay, Treasurer, to the County Auditor, funds due in any settlement of 2008-2009 derived from taxes or other sources, payable to the County Treasurer to the account of Amberley Village, and lawfully applicable for purposes of the current fiscal year.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk of Amberley Village shall forward to the County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
