ORDINANCE 2010-05

ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2010,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it being necessary to amend appropriations so that sufficient monies will be available for obligations to be met.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the additional sum of \$155,500.00 be appropriated in the General Fund for the purpose of paying real estate taxes for the Amberley Green property.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is for the orderly handling of municipal business.
