## **ORDINANCE 2010 – 08**

## ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: Effective as of April 1, 2010, the following rates of compensation shall be paid to the following members of the police department; such compensation, however, to be subject to a deduction for an Ohio Police and Fire Disability and Pension Salary Reduction Method Pick-Up Plan.

- (A) The salary of Lieutenants shall be \$3,206.96 bi-weekly;
- (B) The salary of Sergeant shall be \$2,955.00 bi-weekly;
- (C) The salary of Detective shall be \$2,955.00 bi-weekly;
- (D) The salary of Police Officers who have had at least two years service with the Village shall be \$2,654.78 bi-weekly;
- (E) The salary of Police Officers who have had at least one but less than two years service with the Village shall be \$2,199.34 bi-weekly;
- (F) The salary of starting Police Officers and Police Officers who have less than one year of service with the Village shall be \$1,924.48 bi-weekly.
- (G) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, should a Police Officer at the time he or she commences employment with the Village be a Commissioned Police Officer of the State of Ohio with at least one year of service as a Police Officer with the State of Ohio or a Political Subdivision thereof, such Police Officer, for the purpose of establishing his or her beginning and future rate of compensation under the provisions of this Section, shall be treated from his or her first date of employment with the Village as though on that date he or she had completed one year of employment as a Police Officer with the Village.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is herby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity of maintaining an adequate number of personnel to carry out the work of the Village.
