ORDINANCE 2010 – 13

ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR, MAINTENANCE FOREMAN, AND CREW LEADER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: Effective as of April 1, 2010, the rate of compensation to be paid to the Maintenance Supervisor of the Village shall be not less than \$2,424.00 bi-weekly nor more than \$2,870.00 bi-weekly; such salary, however, to be subject to a deduction for an Ohio PERS Salary Reduction Method Pick-Up Plan.

SECTION 2: Effective as of April 1, 2010, the rate of compensation to be paid to a Maintenance Foreman of the Village shall be not less than \$29.40 per hour nor more than \$30.51 per hour; such salary, however, to be subject to a deduction for an Ohio PERS Salary Reduction Method Pick-Up Plan.

SECTION 3: Effective as of April 1, 2010, the rate of compensation to be paid to a Maintenance Crew Leader of the Village shall be not less than \$28.95 per hour nor more than \$29.25 per hour; such salary, however, to be subject to a deduction for an Ohio PERS Salary Reduction Method Pick-up Plan.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is herby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is the necessity of maintaining an adequate number of personnel to carry out the work of the Village.
