ORDINANCE NO. 2010-25

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER
INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF GOLF MANOR AND THE DEER
PARK-SILVERTON JOINT FIRE DISTRICT FOR THE PROVISION OF PARAMEDIC AND
EMERGENCY SERVICES WITHIN AMBERLEY VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village's Agreement for Paramedic and Emergency Services is to expire on December 31, 2010, and

WHEREAS, Council desiring to continue the contract with the Village of Golf Manor and Deer Park-Silverton Joint Fire District to provide paramedic services and supporting emergency medical services within Amberley Village,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement on behalf of the Village with the Village of Golf Manor and the Deer Park-Silverton Joint Fire Department, for the provision of paramedic and supporting emergency medical services within Amberley Village, a copy of said agreement being attached hereto.

SECTION 2: Commencing January 1, 2011, Amberley Village shall pay to Golf Manor and Deer Park-Silverton, each: for the year 2011, the sum of \$55,000.00, each; for the year 2012, the sum of \$60,000.00 each; for the year 2013, the sum of \$65,000.00, each; for such services.

SECTION 3: The cost is to be payable from the General Fund.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for critical paramedic services to be available to the residents without interruption, and it shall go into effect forthwith.
