<u>SECTION 1:</u> To institute a culling program, not to exceed 50 deer.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: Chief Monahan is authorized to institute the program pursuant to the permits and authorization of the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to perform the same in a safe, responsible and humane manner.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: To resolve to adopt a formal long-term management plan by the end of the year.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
