ORDINANCE NO. 2011-21

ORDINANCE CHANGING THE START TIME OF COUNCIL MEETINGS

WHEREAS, Amberley Village Council currently meets at 7:30p.m. on the second Monday of each month;

WHEREAS, Council determines an earlier starting time would be more accommodating to Council members, staff, and residents, enable more residents to attend meetings, and reduce the time incurred by Village staff to attend meetings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: Section 31.10 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

One regular meeting of the Village Council shall be held each month in the Village Administration Building on the second Monday of that month at 7:30p.m. 6:30p.m., or at such other date and time during that month as may be scheduled by Council during an earlier regular Council meeting.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village. The reason for the said emergency is to accommodate the schedules of Council members, Village staff, and residents and hold meetings at a more acceptable time as soon as possible to facilitate the conduct of Village business.
