## **ORDINANCE 2011-05**

## ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011, <u>AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY</u>

WHEREAS, the Village has previously budgeted funds for expenditures for the fiscal year 2011, and,

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the #100 General Fund 2011 Appropriations be increased not to exceed \$16,000 for the cost of 14 fire hydrants, which will be replaced during the water main replacement project on Hudson Parkway, Belkay Drive, Belkay Lane, Willowbrook Drive, and Willowbrook Lane.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is for the orderly handling of municipality business.
