## ORDINANCE 2012-06

## ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2012, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it being necessary to amend appropriations so that sufficient monies will be available for obligations to be met,

WHEREAS, the Village has previously budgeted funds for expenditures for the fiscal year 2012, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the #250 Employee Severance Payment Fund 2012 Appropriations be increased by \$18,000 for the cost of severance payments due to retiring employee and approve transfer of such funds for payment of severance, as needed.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That the Contingency appropriation within the General Fund be reduced by \$18,000 to keep total appropriations in line with budgeted appropriations.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is for the orderly handling of municipality business and to fulfill the Village's legal obligations in making timely payments to retiring employees.
