ORDINANCE NO. 2012-16

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MAYOR'S COURT AGENCY FUND
AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2012

WHEREAS, in agreement with a recommendation from the State Auditor's Office, Council determines to establish a separate agency fund for the proper recording of revenues received and expenditures made by the Amberley Village Mayor's Court,

WHEREAS, it being necessary to amend appropriations so that sufficient monies will be available for obligations to be met,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby established the following Village fund:

#601 Mayor's Court Agency Fund

SECTION 2: That the sum of \$90,000.00 be appropriated in the #601 Mayor's Court Agency Fund for the purpose of Mayor's Court expenditures.

SECTION 3: That in accordance with Village Charter Article VII, Section 4, this ordinance may be passed upon a single reading and shall become effective forthwith on its adoption.
