RESOLUTION NO. 2012-29

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER  
INTO A CONTRACT WITH DIRECT ENERGY TO PROVIDE  
ELECTRICITY TO THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, due to the recent deregulation of energy in Ohio, the Village has the opportunity to seek a cheaper electricity supply as an alternative to the rates charged by Duke;

WHEREAS, the Village was able to negotiate rates with a company, Direct Energy, which will result in cheaper electricity provided to Village-owned facilities;

WHEREAS, Council determines it is in the best interest of the Village and its residents to approve an agreement with Direct Energy to lower the Village's energy costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring,

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with Direct Energy Business, LLC, substantially in the form as the attached PowerSupply Coordination Service Agreement upon approval of the Solicitor.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
