RESOLUTION NO. 2012-31

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT FOR MOWING SERVICES FOR AMBERLEY GREEN

WHEREAS, While the Village has cut back areas of its maintenance program in order to save money, the Village still requires some essential lawn mowing and landscaping services at Amberley Green and several other areas of the Village;

WHEREAS, Quotes from four contractors were solicited for mowing services at Amberley Green; one contractor did not respond; one contractor chose not to submit a quote based on the project cost; and two companies submitted quotes for the Village's consideration that are both slightly below the Village's costs in 2011;

WHEREAS, Based on the number of service calls, or "cuts," at Amberley Green in 2011, the lowest and best quote was submitted by EMES Lawn Care;

WHEREAS, Council determines it is in the best interest of the Village and its residents to approve an agreement with EMES Lawn Care for mowing services for Amberley Green in 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring,

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with EMES Lawn Care for mowing services for Amberley Green in 2012, conditioned on any written agreements to be approved by the Solicitor.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
