ORDINANCE NO. 2013-05

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 35.06 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO LONGEVITY PAY

WHEREAS, Amberley Village greatly values the hard work and contributions by Village employees and wishes to minimize the impact of changes to their compensation and benefits;

WHEREAS, it is good policy to review and assess compensation and benefits for village employees;

WHEREAS, the Compensation and Benefits Committee has undertaken a series of meetings and discussed the appropriateness of benefit programs and made a recommendation to Council to discontinue longevity pay for all new employees, without affecting longevity pay for existing employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: Section 35.06 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

§ 35.06 LONGEVITY PAY.

- (A) In addition to other wages and benefits granted to employees of the village, the following schedule of annual compensation, payable in a lump sum on the first regular pay date following the anniversary of employment as set forth below, is hereby established:
 - (1) \$500 per year after the completion of 5 years service.
 - (2) \$750 per year after the completion of 10 years service.
 - (3) \$1,000 per year after the completion of 15 years service.
 - (4) \$1,250 per year after the completion of 20 years service.
- (B) The longevity pay provided in paragraph A herein is not available as a benefit for any Village employee hired on or after June 2, 2013.
