ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 07

ORDINANCE CHANGING THE FREQUENCY OF COMPENSATION TO MEMBERS OF COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Amberley Village greatly values the hard work and contributions by members of Village Council;

WHEREAS, existing Ordinance 1998-3 dictates that compensation to council members be made quarterly;

WHEREAS, Ohio state regulations require the Village to issue such compensation at least monthly;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance 1998-3 passed April 13, 1998 be repealed.

SECTION 2: That members of Village Council, not including the Mayor, shall receive as compensation for his or her services to the Village the sum of \$1,200.00 per year, and the member of Council serving as Mayor shall receive as compensation for his or her services the sum of \$3,600.00 per year.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for such emergency is to immediately change the timing and frequency of compensation paid to council members in order to comply with state regulations.
