RESOLUTION TO RE-COMMIT AMBERLEY VILLAGE TO THE WE THRIVE INITIATIVE AND THE GOALS OF THIS INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the Hamilton County Public Health's WE THRIVE initiative generates broad-based support for creating healthy environments where residents live, work, learn and play.

WHEREAS, Amberley Village has experienced real benefits through the WE THRIVE initiative to date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> That the Village hereby recognizes the importance of public health efforts to prevent diseases, protect children, adults and families, and to promote healthy living principles to improve the overall health and vitality of the Village residents. In light of the foregoing considerations, the Village supports Hamilton County Public Health's WE THRIVE initiative.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> That the Village will again establish a WE THRIVE team that will be responsible for leading community health and wellness efforts and serving as a liaison between the Village and Hamilton County Public Health.

SECTION 3: That the Village authorizes the WE THRIVE team to select at least one Pathway and work through each Pathway's process with representatives from Hamilton County Public Health. The Village's WE THRIVE team will collaborate with Hamilton County Public Health on an ongoing basis to work through additional Pathways, existing or newly established, to improve the overall health and well-being of our community.

<u>SECTION 4:</u> That the Village WE THRIVE team shall designate a representative to participate in the WE THRIVE Community Learning Collaborative facilitated by Hamilton County Public Health.

<u>SECTION 5:</u> That the Village's WE THRIVE team will meet with the Health, Education and Welfare Committee of the Council of Amberley Village on a quarterly basis to review progress against identified steps.

SECTION 6 : This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earlies period allowed by law.
