RESOLUTION NO. 2014-29

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER
TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ESP MEDIA FOR
COUNCIL MEETING RECORDING SERVICES

WHEREAS, Council determines it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to provide public access to Council meetings, including access by television and/or the Internet;

WHEREAS, Amberley Village has been using ICRC to provide television and Internet coverage of council meetings and other events of local interest;

WHEREAS, the Public Outreach Committee has considered and recommends a proposal by ESP Media to provide similar services to the Village at a lower cost;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with vendor ESP Media to provide video and Internet access of Village Council meetings consistent with ESP Media's proposal for such services, which proposal is attached hereto and incorporated herein. Such services do not include those pertaining to social media or mobile devices.

SECTION 2: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to cancel the existing contract between the Village and ICRC, in writing and deliver said notice to ICRC before November 1, 2014.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
