RESOLUTION NO. 2015-6

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE TWO NEW POLICE CRUISERS UNDER THE STATE OF OHIO CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Village Police Department provides valuable and essential services to the Village and its residents;

WHEREAS, from time to time the Village must purchase new equipment to replace that which has become outdated, inefficient, or unusable;

WHEREAS, the Police Department determined, and Council agrees, that several existing police cruisers have reached the end of their useful lives such that there is a need to purchase new vehicles to replace the older equipment that that has since become unreliable and costly to maintain;

WHEREAS, the Village has the opportunity to purchase two new police cruisers from Byers Chevrolet through the State of Ohio Purchasing Contract, which will yield good value for the new equipment at a price lower than the Village could achieve in the open market;

WHEREAS, the Police and Fire Committee met to consider the request and recommends purchase of two new police cruisers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with Byers Chevrolet for the purchase of two 2015 Chevy Tahoe 4x4 police cruisers at \$31,649 each for a total price of \$63,298. Over and above the purchase price, the Village Manager is authorized to pay any reasonable administrative fees charged as a condition of participating in the State of Ohio Purchasing Contract.

SECTION 2: This purchase is being made through the State of Ohio Purchasing Contract. The Clerk is hereby directed to file with the State a certified copy of this resolution. This resolution shall be considered by the State as a request for the Village to participate in the State of Ohio Purchasing Contract under ORC 125.04 and 5513.01. The Village agrees to be bound by such terms and conditions as the State prescribes and that the Village will directly pay the vendor under each purchase contract.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
