RESOLUTION NO. 2016-7

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO PURCHASE A PICKUP TRUCK FROM BUICK GMC OF BEACHWOOD

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Department performs a significant amount of valuable and necessary work for Village residents through the use of pickup trucks and snow fighting equipment;

WHEREAS, from time to time the Village must purchase new equipment to replace that which has become outdated, inefficient, or unusable;

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Department determined, and Council finds, that an existing vehicle has reached the end of its useful life and it has become unreliable and costly to maintain;

WHEREAS, the Village has the opportunity to purchase a new pickup truck through the State of Ohio Purchasing Contract, specifically a 2016 GMC 1500 Double Cab pickup truck for the base price of \$28,259.90;

WHEREAS, Council finds and determines that the purchase of the new vehicle is necessary and reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with Buick GMC of Beachwood for the purchase of a new 2016 GMC 1500 Double Cab pickup truck, for the base price of \$28,259.90. Over and above those amounts, the Village Manager is authorized to pay any reasonable administrative fees charged as a condition of participating in the State of Ohio Purchasing Contract.

SECTION 2: This purchase is being made through the State of Ohio Purchasing Contract. The Clerk is hereby directed to file with the State a certified copy of this resolution. This resolution shall be considered by the State as a request for the Village to participate in the State of Ohio Purchasing Contract under ORC 125.04 and 5513.01. The Village agrees to be bound by such terms and conditions as the State prescribes and that the Village will directly pay the vendor under the purchase contract.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
