RESOLUTION NO. 2016-9

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER  
TO PURCHASE ACCESSORIES FOR MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT VEHICLES**

**WHEREAS**, the Maintenance Department performs a significant amount of valuable and necessary work for Village residents through the use of pickup trucks and snow fighting equipment;

**WHEREAS**, from time to time the Village must purchase new equipment to replace that which has become outdated, inefficient, or unusable;

**WHEREAS**, Council is authorizing the purchase of three new pickup trucks for the Maintenance Department, which will require the installation of accessory equipment such as light bars, sirens, and lettering;

**WHEREAS**, the Village received a quote from vendor Camp Safety Equipment to purchase the necessary accessories for all three vehicles for a total price of \$14,379, which Council finds to be necessary and reasonable;

**WHEREAS**, Council finds and determines that the purchase of this snow plow equipment is necessary and reasonable;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE** Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1:** That the Village Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with Camp Safety Equipment to purchase accessories for Maintenance Department vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$14,379, consistent with the quotation dated December 23, 2015 which is incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2:** This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
