Optional dates for renewal of levy:

1. 2016 General Election date of November 8, 2016:
 - August 10, 2016, 90 days before election, is the deadline to submit
2. 2017 Primary Election date of May 2, 2017
 - a. February 1, 2017, 90 days before election, is the deadline to submit
3. 2017 General Election date of November 7, 2017:
 - a. August 9, 2017, 90 days before election, is the deadline to submit

Submitting request to County Auditor

- a. Resolution must be submitted at least 1 month in advance of BOE deadline for ballot issue

Submitting request to Board of Elections

- a. Resolution must be approved after County Auditor responds and prior to election deadline
