SUMMARY STATEMENT: The city has in the past abandoned a portion of this street right of way at the request of the Angleton Drainage District, the Ellison estate and others. These property owners request that their portion be abandoned since the city apparently has no intent to make this a public road. There is one tract, which is owned on both sides by Terry Novak, Lorrie Novak, Nicholas Kieth and Torie Kieth .
