

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-O-10B

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS, APPOINTING THE CITY REPRESENTATIVES TO THE TAX INCREMENT REINVESTMENT ZONE (TIRZ) ONE BOARD; PROVIDING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2004-O-11A created the TIRZ One zone and appointed the initial members of the Board of Directors for such TIRZ; and

WHEREAS, the city council members of the City of Angleton, Texas, serve as the City's representative on said board; and

WHEREAS, said city council members' terms to the city council coincide with the terms of said council members on the TIRZ One board, and if not, shall coincide after the passage of this ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS, DULY ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. That the City Council members, upon their taking of each respective oath of office for the office of city council member of the City of Angleton, Texas, shall from this day forward, be automatically appointed to serve as the City's representatives on the TIRZ One Board of Directors; said council members (including the Mayor) shall serve on the TIRZ One Board for the same time period that they serve as a city council member. When a new city council member is elected or appointed to fill the position of city council member, that person shall automatically serve as a city representative on the Board of Directors of TIRZ One until said person resigns or is replaced for any other reason, including by election.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall eliminate the need for the appointment of city representatives on the Board of Directors of TIRZ One from this date forward unless this Ordinance is repealed or modified by the city council. This Ordinance has no application to representatives of

any other governmental body or private body on said board and applies only to the city of Angleton's representatives on said Board.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION 4. If any section or part of this Ordinance is unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, then such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity of such section or part shall in no way effect, impair, or invalidate the remaining portion thereof, but such remaining portion shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and adoption.
