

**ORDINANCE NO. 2007-O-10A**

**AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING AN ERROR IN ORDINANCE NO. 2007-O-9B WHICH LEVIED TAXES FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON AND WHICH PROVIDED FOR THE INTEREST AND SINKING FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008 AND WHICH APPROPRIATED EACH LEVY FOR A SPECIFIC PURPOSE, AND ORDERED SAID TAXES ASSESSED AND COLLECTED.**

**WHEREAS**, at the September regular meeting of the Angleton City Council the City passed Ordinance No. 2007-O-9B which levied taxes for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and said Ordinance contained a typographical error;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2007-0-9B should be and hereby is corrected to read as follows:

**“SECTION 1. There is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government of the City of Angleton, Texas and to provide interest and sinking funds for the fiscal year Two thousand six - Two thousand seven (2007-2008), upon all property, real, personal and mixed within the corporate limits of said city, a tax of .706 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) valuation of property, said tax being so levied and apportioned to the specific purpose herein set forth:**

- a. For the maintenance and support of the general government (General Fund), a tax of .552755 on each One Hundred Dollar (\$100) valuation of property, and**
- b. For the interest and sinking fund a tax of .153245 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) valuation of property.”**

**SECTION 2.** In all other respects, Ordinance No. 2007-O-9B shall remain unchanged.
