

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-O-9B

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON AND PROVIDING FOR THE INTEREST AND SINKING FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008 AND APPROPRIATING EACH LEVY FOR A SPECIFIC PURPOSE, AND ORDERING SAID TAXES ASSESSED AND COLLECTED.

WHEREAS, the City has duly complied with all state requirements regarding notification of the public; and

WHEREAS, two public hearings were duly held on September 10 and September 13, 2007 and all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearings was published in the local newspaper on August 31, 2007; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation, study and consideration the City Council is of the opinion that the tax rate set out below should be approved and adopted; and

WHEREAS, THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$9.95.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government of the City of Angleton, Texas and to provide interest and sinking funds for the fiscal year Two thousand six - Two thousand seven (2007-2008), upon all property, real, personal and mixed within the corporate limits of said city, a tax of .706 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) valuation of property, said tax being so levied and apportioned to the specific purpose herein set forth:

- a. For the maintenance and support of the general government (General Fund), a tax of .552858 on each One Hundred Dollar (\$100) valuation of property, and
- b. For the interest and sinking fund a tax of .153245 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) valuation of property.

SECTION 2. All moneys collected under this Ordinance shall be and the same are appropriated and set apart for the specific purpose indicated in the City Budget. All receipts for the City not specifically apportioned by the Ordinance are hereby made payable to the General Fund of said City.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION 4. If any section or part of this Ordinance is unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, then such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity of such section or part shall in no way effect, impair or invalidate the remaining portion thereof, but such remaining portion shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and adoption.
