SUMMARY STATEMENT:

Brazoria County needs a connection from the Juvenile Detention Center to the existing city system in the “Houston, Dallas Streets” area. They have agreed to reimburse the City for a 12” water line from the existing 8” to the center and connect to the existing 6” water main from the south. This will give them a looped system and allow them to meet the requirements of the Fire Marshall for the Center expansion. It also conforms to the ultimate utility plan for the area.

Project needs to be declared a “necessity to preserve or protect the public health or safety” to allow immediate processing of quotes as the time needed to obtain the necessary permit from UPRR will jeopardize the ability of the County to meet code at the time the expansion is complete.

County will provide an interlocal agreement for signature by City early next week.

Recommendation: Approve project.
