

**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-R-1A
THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS
RESOLUTION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE
BRAZORIA COUNTY STORM WATER QUALITY COALITION**

WHEREAS, the USEPA has promulgated regulations to requiring local governments to commit to and implement measures to reduce pollution impacts to storm water within defined urbanized areas, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has adopted the requirements and set a deadline of February 11, 2008 for compliance with these new requirements, and

WHEREAS, The City of Angleton, Texas operates storm water collection and conveyance systems within a defined urbanized area, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality through its requirements allows multiple small MS4 operators to combine or share efforts in meeting any or all of the Storm Water Management Program (SWMP) requirements of the general permit, and

WHEREAS, the City of Angleton, Texas finds it financially advantageous to combine or share efforts with other local governmental entities to meet the requirements of the general permit, and

WHEREAS, other affected local governmental entities have joined together to work cooperatively to comply with the upcoming deadline for compliance and have agreed to form a cooperative to be known as the Brazoria County Storm Water Quality Coalition.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, BRAZORIA COUNTY, STATE OF TEXAS:

The City of Angleton intends to work cooperatively as a member of the Brazoria County Storm Water Quality Coalition in efforts to enhance the quality of storm water in urbanized areas within the District.
