SUMMARY STATEMENT:

Several months ago council wanted to revisit the “Eight Liner Ordinance” but delayed any action until after the district attorney’s office clarified whether said businesses would be allowed to continue to operate. They are still operating and therefore I have increased the certification fee (which is a one time fee) from roughly \$10 per machine to \$12 per machine; and the annual licensing fee from \$150 to \$200 per machine per year. In addition, I amended the minimum distance from such businesses and churches, schools, day cares and hospitals, from 300 to 1000 feet.

Recommendation: Approve the amendments to the eight liners Ordinance.
