We have reviewed the construction of Hospital Drive for Moody Bank and find the water, sewer, paving, and storm sewer and related appurtenances conform to the approved plans and specifications. The only punch list item remaining is the installation of a barricade at the east end of Downing. JACO has made arrangements for United Rentals to instal a 34' wide barricade at the end of Hospital Drive.

Attached is Uticon's letter in which they have agreed to extend the warranty for a section of pavement which did not meet specifications for flexural strength.

We recommend that the City accept the water, sewer, storm sewer and paving for maintenance.
