**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** Board member attendance has become a problem. The current ordinance requires the board or director to enforce attendance requirements. This is an awkward situation. Also, the current attendance requirement of not missing three meetings in a row is inadequate. One current member has missed 12 of the last 21 meetings without missing three meetings in a row.

The revision KAB wishes to change establishes a 75% attendance requirement with missing three meetings in a row, or a fourth meeting, as an automatic resignation. If extenuating circumstances exist, that member may reapply for the open position and City Council may reappoint the member if deemed appropriate. This keeps the KAB Director from having to police a member of the board they work for and alleviates the awkwardness of the remaining board members determining if the absences are acceptable.
