

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-O-10B

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS: SHADY OAKS DRIVE/ENCHANTED OAKS DRIVE, SOUTHERN OAKS DRIVE/SHADY OAKS DRIVE, AND TEXIAN TRAIL SOUTH/BUCHTA ROAD, ALL WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF POLICE OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ERECT AND MAINTAIN SIGNS STATING SUCH REGULATIONS; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN \$200.00 FOR EACH VIOLATION, OR THE MAXIMUM ALLOWED BY TEXAS LAW FOR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS; PROVIDING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AFTER ITS PASSAGE.

WHEREAS this Ordinance is authorized by relevant Texas statutes, including the Transportation Code and Texas vehicle laws; and either the residents or city officers or employees have requested that the City of Angleton, Texas, pass this Ordinance; and the City Council of the City of Angleton finds that this Ordinance will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Angleton;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS, DULY ASSEMBLED:

- I. The need for the placement of the following stop signs at the following locations has been established as necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Angleton:
 - a) On Shady Oaks Drive where it intersects with Enchanted Oaks Drive;
 - b) On Southern Oaks Drive where it intersects with Shady Oaks Drive;
 - c) On Texian Trail South where it intersects with Buchta Road;
- II. The placement of said stop signs and the enforcement of same by the appropriate law enforcement agencies is hereby determined and declared to be reasonable, prudent and safe.
- III. The Chief of Police of the City of Angleton (or his designee) is hereby directed to erect and maintain such signs as are necessary to effectuate and to notify the public of the new stop signs established in this Ordinance.
- IV. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not more than \$200.00, or the maximum sum allowed by state law, whichever is greater, for each separate offense.
- V. If any section or part of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, then such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity of such section or part shall in no way affect,

impair, or invalidate the remaining portion hereof, and such remaining portion shall remain in full force and effect.

- VI. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and adoption.
