

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-R-7A

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE PARTICIPATION IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION PROGRAM; FINDING THAT THE MEETING COMPLIED WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Angleton, that the Criminal Justice Division Grant be operated for the year 2010; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Criminal Justice Division grant application in which electronic equipment for fingerprinting and surveillance, as well as computer laptops, will be purchased; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas designates J. Patrick Henry, Mayor of the City of Angleton, Texas, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The findings set out in the preamble to this resolution are in all things approved and adopted.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas approves submission of the grant application for the Angleton Equipment Grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division;

Section 3. The meeting at which this resolution was approved was in all things conducted in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective from and after its passage.
