Ordinance No. 2009-O-7A and Angleton Water Conservation Drought Contingency Plan

Summary Statement:

The State of Texas requires that we periodically review, update and modify our Water Conservation–Drought Contingency Plan to insure water conservation in the event of a drought. Angleton’s Drought Contingency Plan was last reviewed and modified in April of 2005 over four years ago. The attached Plan modifies and updates the 2005 version of the plan based on recent years of water use in the city.
