Discussion of ORDINANCE NO. 2009-O-6A, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-O-9B AND SECTION 5-19 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON ESTABLISHING REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTORS, SUBCONTRACTORS AND ANYONE DOING CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR WORK, LABOR OR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY TO REGISTER WITH THE CITY AND TO PROVIDE PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE OR TO BE LICENSED BY THE TEXAS RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION COMMISSION; ESTABLISHING AN EXPIRATION DATE OF ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OF THE CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION; ESTABLISHING A REGISTRATION FEE; PROVIDING EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$500 FOR EACH VIOLATION AND MAKING EACH DAY OR PORTION OF A DAY THE VIOLATION CONTINUES A SEPARATE VIOLATION; PROVIDING FOR AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALER AND A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE CLAUSE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**Summary Statement:**

This Ordinance amends Ordinance No. 2008-O-9B which the City Council passed on September 23, 2008, requiring contractors during construction on structures or concrete paving to register with the City and provide a copy of their liability policy to the building department except for those that had a license from the Texas Residential Construction Commission or residents doing work on their home. This Ordinance provides a process for appealing any refusal to issue a certificate of registration, the revocation of such certificate or from a stop work order, makes the insurance policy limits more consistent with the City's limits of liability under the Torts Claims Act and sets standards for revoking a certificate of registration.
