To Whom it may concern,



## Good Neighbor Policy

This agreement is made by and between The Icehouse Bar and Grill (Icehouse) located at 2016 N Velasco Angleton, Texas 77515 and the musical group known as

\_\_\_\_\_ (Band) and the manager or lead contact, individually, whose name appears below.

It shall be a violation of this policy for the Band to make, assist in making, permit, continue, cause to be made or continued or permit the continuance of any sound which are sound nuisances which are unreasonably loud, irritating, disturbing, or excessive which unreasonably disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health, peace, or safety of others within the hearing distance.

The Band shall measure the sound created by the band by use of a Type 1 or Type 2 calibrated sound level meter utilizing the A-weighting scale and the slow meter response as specified by the American National Standards Institute (A.N.S.I. S1.4-1984/85A). Sound levels shall be measured in decibels and A-weighted. The unit of measurement shall be designated as dB(A). Meters shall be maintained in calibration and good working order. Calibrations shall be employed which meet A.N.S.I. S1.40-1984 prior to sampling of sound. Measurements recorded shall be taken so as to provide a proper representation of the sound being measured. The microphone of said meter shall be positioned so as not to create any unnatural enhancement or diminution of the measured sound.

The decibels shall not exceed 100 db(A) inside the Icehouse and shall at no time, steady or peak greater than 85 db(A) outside of the Icehouse.
