DECLARING THE REMOVAL OF CLEAN-OUT CAPS A PUBLIC NUISANCE; TO PROHIBIT THE FILLING OR BLOCKING OF A DRAINAGE EASEMENT OR DITCH OR FAILING TO MAINTAIN SAME FREE FROM DEBRIS IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES AND DECLARING SAME A PUBLIC NUISANCE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000 FOR EACH VIOLATION AND MAKING EACH DAY OR PORTION OF A DAY THAT A VIOLATION CONTINUES A SEPARATE VIOLATION; PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALER AND A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
