**SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

I have briefed each of you in the past on the presentation of this request. At this time, I recommend that we do NOT assign our contract over to Waste Connections. First, I think the rate should go back to January 1, 2009 rates as I feel that they had knowledge that the hauling contract was going to be for sale. Secondly, I cannot find any city our size that is in Texas that is currently served by Waste Connection and I believe this should be discussed and, thirdly, we need some more time to work through some other issues with the new company, i.e.; length of contract (2 years, with option to renew for 8-10 years) recycling, involvement in the community and better definitions of the contract. This is a one-time opportunity to improve the contract for the residents.

I have met with the new General Manager of Waste Connections and discussed some of these issues.
