The City of Angleton, Texas, City Council will conduct a Special Meeting beginning at 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 18, 2010 at City Hall, 121 S. Velasco, Angleton, TX, to consider the following:

1. Declaration of quorum and call to order.
2. Discussion and possible action on ORDINANCE NO. 2010-O-5A, AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS ON MAY 8, 2010; ENTERING AN ORDER IN THE RECORDS OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON DECLARING THAT SIX (6) CHARTER AMENDMENTS HAVE PASSED BY MAJORITY VOTE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REGISTER OF VOTING INFORMATION WHICH IS ADOPTED AND ATTACHED TO THIS ORDINANCE; ENTERING AN ORDER IN THE CITY'S RECORDS DECLARING THAT SIX (6) CHARTER AMENDMENTS ARE ADOPTED; PROVIDING THE MAYOR CERTIFY AUTHENTICATED COPY OF CHARTER AMENDMENTS TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE; DIRECTING THE CITY SECRETARY TO PROPERLY RECORD CHARTER AMENDMENTS IN CITY'S RECORDS; PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR OTHER PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
3. Statement of Officers.
4. Oaths of Office and swearing in of new council members by Judge Pat Sebesta.
5. Certificate of Election issued to newly-elected officers.
6. Discussion and possible action on appointment of Mayor Pro Tem for the Angleton City Council.
7. Council will adjourn into executive session as authorized by:

- a) Texas Government Code Section 551.074 (*Personnel Matters*) to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of the City Manager, with possible discussion and action related thereto in open session; and
- b) Texas Government Code Section 551.074 (*Personnel Matters*) to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of the Municipal Court Judge, with possible discussion and action related thereto in open session.

7. Adjourn.
